Membership is open to all persons who desire to take an active part in Club Activities. Two types of membership are available:

Membership: Open to anyone 18 years of age or older and their families who own interest in a yacht*. (Members are not automatically reclassified upon liquidating their interest in a yacht.)

Associate Membership: Open to anyone who has an interest in sailing but does not own interest in a yacht*. (Associate Members have no voting privileges and may not hold office, but may serve on committees.)

*For the purpose of membership type determination, the term "yacht" is defined as a sailboat designed for racing or a boat (sail or power) which has overnight cruising accommodations.
