USE OF THE RECIPROCAL MOORAGE PROGRAM

This guide has been compiled to assist you in the use and enjoyment of our reciprocal moorage agreements with other yacht clubs. Please take a few minutes to look through this edit on, and note any changes to club facilities since your last visit. This book is for you; so please don't hesitate to advise us of any ideas you have that might add to its usefulness. Washington, Other U.S., clubs outside Washington, and Canadian yacht clubs are grouped for easy use. There are also sections for Canadian Emergency information, Flag Etiquette, and your own notes. If you are unfamiliar with the reciprocal program, The basics are covered below.

Like anything else that's new and unfamiliar, you may be hesitant to try it. (Remember the first time you talked on the VHF radio?) It is no different from pulling up to any marina and asking if moorage is available for the night. When you first arrive at the host club facility, contact the Harbor Master and ask if there is reciprocal moorage available. He may ask to see your yacht club card (good reason to keep it on the boat). And if space is available, he will direct you to the proper pier. If reciprocal moorage space is all taken, ask if there is other space available. This may well be the case, if the reciprocal moorage is part of a large marina (as is our case). If the moorage is part of a yacht club, he might direct you to a nearby marina. This process can be made even easier yet if you call on VHF radio first. Many facilities monitor channel 16, or another channel as may be noted in this book, and all of them have someone on duty who can help you.

As can be seen by reviewing the guide, we have moorage agreements with yacht clubs, which have their own facilities, as well as those, which rent space in marinas. Refer to the guide to help you locate the facility, and be aware of check-in requirements and any specific limitations. Where known, latitude and longitude are provided to facilitate finding the moorage.

In using this booklet, please make notes regarding things (both good and bad) that would be useful to you when you keep your own garden. **Print, use, and use your program and have fun.**

useful to others when visiting the reciprocal facilities.

If you are visiting a facility that does not have a latitude and longitude listed, please make a note of the coordinates from your GPS or Loran and pass the information on for next year's book. Other information which is always appreciated, is that concerning the location and distance to the nearest food market and laundry, the names and specialties of any good restaurants, "neat" shops, points of interest, etc. Feedback is a valuable part of this book because many of the clubs don't tell us of changes, they just send a new reciprocal card, and some clubs don't give us anything new because they have given us reciprocal rights on a permanent basis.

FLAG ETIQUETTE ORDER OF PRECEDENCE:

Flags are flown in the following order of precedence: The Ensign; Courtesy Flag; Club Burgee or Flag Officer's Flag; Owner's House Flag; Other Flags.

The Ensign:

This is the national flag, and denotes the nationality of the owner of the vessel, and should be flown between the hours of 8:00 AM and sunset. However, the Ensign may be flown day and night while at sea and should be flown at any hour when entering or leaving port.
Courtesy Flag: The ensign of a foreign country being visited should be raised upon entering the waters of that country and should be lowered at sunset and raised at 8:00 AM daily for the duration of the visit. Upon leaving the foreign waters, the courtesy flag should be flown until the yacht clears customs at the next country visited or its homeport. Once customs has been cleared, the courtesy flag should immediately be lowered.

Club Burgee:

The burgee should be flown between the hours of 8:00 AM and sunset. If the owners a member of more than one club, the burgee of the host club or the burgee of the club under which the owner wishes to be recognized should be flown. Only one burgee should be flown at a time.
Flag Officer's Flag: When the owner is a Flag Officer of the Club, his special Flag Officer's flag replaces the burgee and is flown from 8:00 AM until sunset.
Owner's House Flag: Private flag of the owner flown from 8:00 AM until sunset customarily only when the owner is actually aboard.

Other Flags:

U.S. Power Squadron, Blue Gavel, etc., have low priority, and could replace the seldom-used owner's flag, being flown between 8:00 AM and sunset. Care should be taken that they are never hoisted in a position superior to the ensign, club burgee, flag officer's flag, courtesy flag or owner's flag.

Where to fly flags:

The Ensign:

Gaff rigged sloops, cutters and schooners. The ensign is flown from the main peak or taff-rail staff while under sail and the taff-rail staff while under power or at anchor. Bermudian rigged sloops, cutters and schooners - Ensign flown from the taff-rail staff or two thirds up the leach of the mainsail while sailing and at the taff-rail staff while under power or at anchor. Yawls, ketches and yachts with more than two masts where the after mast is shorter than the main mast the ensign may be flown from the staff at the mizzen head. Power yachts with an after mast fitted

masthead; these flags should be flown from the starboard spreader of the main mast on single masted yachts, yawls and ketches. On schooners, they should be flown from the mast truck.

NOTE: When a flag officer's flag is flown no burgee is flown as it replaces the burgee. **Owner's House Flag:**

In single masted yachts the house flag should be flown at the starboard spreader or if this halyard is occupied, the port spreader. In schooners or yachts with more than two masts, the house flag should be flown from the fore masthead. In yawls and ketches it may be flown at the mizzen masthead if free, otherwise, the main mast spreader.

Courtesy Flag:

(In foreign waters) on single masted vessels, it should be flown at the starboard spreader, where it has preference. On yachts with more than one mast, it may be flown at the starboard spreader of the main mast or at the fore masthead on schooners..

Saluting:

It is customary for yachts, as well as commercial vessels, to
SALUTE ANY WARSHIP, U.S. OR FOREIGN. FLAG OFFICER'S, WHEN FLYING THEIR FLAG, SHOULD
ALSO RECEIVE A SALUTE.

Procedure for Saluting:

When cruising in Company the Senior Officer only salutes for all the yachts in the squadron. Saluting is done by "dipping" the ensign only, i.e., lowering it slowly to a position about one-third from the lower end of the hoist. The saluted vessel should acknowledge the salute in kind. The dip should be held until the saluted vessel hoists her ensign.

Half masting: It is customary on days of national mourning to fly the ensign at half-mast during the period of morning, i.e., the time the information is received until the funeral has been held. In case of the death of a yacht owner the ensign and burgee should be half-masted at the time the information is received and at sunset hauled down for the last time. Should news be received during the hours of darkness, the ensign and burgee should be half-masted the next day and finally hauled down at sunset of that day. If ashes are to be scattered at sea the ensign and burgee should be half-masted during the ceremony.

Procedure for Half Mastings:

The ensign and burgee should never be hoisted direct to, or lowered direct from, the half-mast position. When being hoisted they should be hauled close up, then after a pause lowered to the dip position. Similarly, when being lowered they should first be hauled close up, then after a pause lowered. The Half-mast position should be about three breadths of the flag from the close up position.

By other methods

Currently the U.S. Coast Guard email system is not set up to accept or respond to emergency SAR messages. If you are in distress or need to report an emergency, do NOT send it via email, contact the Coast Guard via telephone or radio.
The Global Maritime Distress and Safety System (GMDS) provides number of additional means for contacting or alerting SAR authorities. These include INMARSAT, SARSAT (EPIRBs, ELTs, and PLBs), MF-DSC, HF-DSC, etc.
In addition, for vessels or persons in distress there are nationally and internationally accepted/prescribed visual and sound distress signals (flares, horns, mirrors, flashing lights, flags, etc.).

CELLULAR TELEPHONES ON BOATS

The Coast Guard does not advocate cellular phones as a substitute for the regular maritime radio distress and safety systems recognized by the Federal Communications Commission and the International Radio Regulations - particularly VHF maritime radio. However, cellular phones can have a place on board as an added measure of safety.

CELLULAR PHONE LIMITATIONS IN AN EMERGENCY

- o Cellular phones generally cannot provide ship to ship safety communications or communications with rescue vessels. If you make a distress call on a cellular phone, only the one party you call will be able to hear you.
 - o Most cellular phones are designed for a land-based service. Their coverage offshore is limited, and may change without notice.
 - o Locating a cellular caller is hard to do. If you don't know precisely where you are, the Coast Guard will have difficulty finding your location on the water.
 - o In some areas, however, cellular providers have established a special code (*CG) which, if you are in range, will connect you directly to a Coast Guard Operations Center. This service may only work with the carrier to which you have subscribed.

VHF marine radios were designed with safety in mind. If you are in distress, calls can be received not only by the Coast Guard but by ships which may be in position to give immediate assistance. A VHF marine radio also helps ensure that storm warnings and other urgent marine information broadcasts are received. The Coast Guard announces these broadcasts on VHF channel 16. Timely receipt of such information may save your life. Additionally, your VHF marine radio can be used anywhere in the United States or around the world.

On VHF radios, however, conversations are not private and individual boats cannot be assigned a personal phone number. If you are expecting a call, channel 16 or the marine operator's working channel must be continually monitored.

SHOULD YOU RELY ON A CELLULAR PHONE EXCLUSIVELY?

Actually there is no comparison between cellular phones and VHF marine radio. They normally provide different services. The cellular phone is best used for what it is, an on board telephone -- a link with shore based telephones. A VHF marine radio is intended for communication with other ships or marine installations -- and a powerful ally in time of emergency.

If you have a portable or hand held cellular telephone, by all means take it aboard. If you are boating very far off shore, a cellular phone is no substitute for a VHF radio. But, if you are within cellular range, it may provide an additional means of communication.
